TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TERMS

We accept Cash, Visa, Master Card, Discover, American Express, and company checks with proper identification. To customers with established credit and a history of prompt payment we will extend the credit terms of; payment due within 30 days of the invoicing.

Past due accounts will be subject to a service charge of 2% per month or 24% annually. Shipments will not be made to customers whose accounts are delinquent unless shipped C.O.D. In the event it becomes necessary for our firm to file suit to enforce payment, we shall be entitled to court cost, attorney's fees in the sum of 1/3 of the unpaid balance and interest at the rate of 2% per month on all amounts due and payable. We assume no liability for delays or failure to fill orders or deliveries due to causes beyond our control, including but not limited to; weather and animal damage. We do not guarantee the future life or productiveness of plant material, only that they will leave our yard in good healthy condition, free from diseases and be true to name. In no event shall we be liable for an amount greater than the original price paid. For all customers, including customers with approved credit, orders with special pricing or discounts must be paid for at time of purchase. There will be a \$35 service charge on all bad checks.

CLAIMS

Every effort will be made to fill your order as requested and we do not anticipate any claims. Upon receipt of shipment you should examine and count all material. No claim will be honored unless it is made in writing on the Bill of Lading upon receipt of the shipment. We also request that you notify the office immediately by phone if there is a count discrepancy, or damage has occurred.

DELIVERY SERVICE

Delivery may be arranged on our trucks at very reasonable rates, we wish only to cover our costs. We have a limited capability for deliveries out of our area, therefore we encourage you to come with your own truck to see and select your own order. Delivery charge includes a 2 hour unloading time for a full trailer, a \$60.00 per hour demurrage fee will be added to the balance due if the allotted unload time is exceeded.

PICKING UP STOCK WITH YOUR TRUCK

We will supply all labor to load your truck. It is the responsibility of the customer to provide an adequate truck cover. We strongly recommend covering all open trucks! We cannot entertain complaints on condition of material if hauled without being covered. Covers are available for purchase if needed.



RETURNS/RE STOCKING

There will be a 20% handling charge on any nursery stock returned ONLY after inspection and accepted, as well as for items cancelled within 48 hours of delivery or pick-up

SPECIAL ORDERS

A 1/3 deposit in advance is required on all special orders. Any material tagged for pick up will be held for 7 days only. We cannot be responsible thereafter.

DISCOUNTS

Details of discount plans are available from your sales representative or our office.
